Evening/Weekend Permit

Definition & Purpose

The Evening/Weekend permit is essential for employees and students who work or study on campus after normal business hours. This does not apply to annual individual parking permit holders.

Rules and Regulations

- The permit allows parking in any non-residential or un-gated lot from 5:00 pm to 8:00 am, Monday through Thursday and on weekends from 5:00 pm Friday to 8:00 am Monday.
- Evening/Weekend customers may choose one gated zone (except E45, E48, E82 and W23) upon purchasing a permit.
- For an additional fee, patrons can also customize these permits to allow access at 2:00 pm, 3:00 pm or 4:00 pm.

Restrictions

- There may be times when permit holders will be notified in writing and required to park in other areas of campus. This is a condition of acceptance of the evening/weekend parking assignment.
- Evening/Weekend Permits are not valid outside of the designated lots.
- Evening/Weekend permits are not valid in restricted areas such as: fire lanes, meters, reserved stalls, disabled stalls (without the proper GT disability designation) loading zones, construction areas, sidewalks, disabled access aisles, driveways, grass areas or lots staffed during Special Event(s). Parking with permits in restricted areas will result in a citation.
- Failure to follow GT PTS rules and regulations may result in your parking privileges being revoked.
- All citations and other unpaid fees that are due to GT PTS must be paid prior to purchasing an evening/weekend permit.
